

Privacy Policy

Pterodactyl, LLC, dba LegacyVault.com (“LEGACYVAULT”) is committed to protecting your privacy when you visit LegacyVault.com or pages with the LegacyVault.com domain name or use its Services. By using or accessing this website, or any website hosted at the LegacyVault.com domain name (the "Site"), or by using any of the content hosting and sharing services provided via the Site (including without limitation any APIs) ("Services"), you ("You" or "Member") agree to be bound by the terms of this privacy policy (“Privacy Policy”). Please read the terms of this Privacy Policy carefully. If you do not agree to these terms, then you may not use or access the Site or any of the Services. Please review this Privacy Policy periodically as we may update it from time to time. If this policy is updated again you will be notified with a screen message as you access your account or via email.

Each time you visit the Site, use the Services, or provide us with information, you are accepting the practices described in this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy incorporates by reference LEGACYVAULT Terms and Conditions and LEGACYVAULT Acceptable Use Policy (collectively, “Agreement”). You agree that by using the Site you are expressly and affirmatively consenting with the terms of this Agreement.

As a condition of using the Services of LEGACYVAULT, you agree to provide certain personal information. This information includes, but is not limited to: full name, postal address, phone number and email address as well as your computer's unique IP address, financial/credit card information and demographic information.

Children's Privacy

This service is for use by adults over the age of 18 only, and any data entered into your account concerning any minor children of any age is encrypted and cannot be read or accessed by any LEGACYVAULT personnel. LEGACYVAULT recognizes the privacy interests of children and we encourage parents and guardians to take an active role in their children's online activities and interests. This Site is not intended for children under the age of 13. LEGACYVAULT does not target its Services or this Site to children under 13. LEGACYVAULT does not intentionally collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of 13.

Password / Security

Your data is encrypted using a security key automatically created when you make your LegacyVault account. This security key is then encrypted with your password, which is not stored on LEGACYVAULT servers; however a hash to confirm your correct password is stored on LEGACYVAULT servers. When you login to your account, your security key is decrypted with the provided password,

and we are then able to access your data for the duration of your session. This means that your security key can only be accessed with your password, and even LEGACYVAULT personnel cannot see any of your data. If you lose your password, **your data is only recoverable if you have selected and your account activators have accepted the appointment.** It is important to complete the setup of your activation system, which provides an only method of recovering your security key.

Pursuant to the terms of this Agreement and LEGACYVAULT's policies, YOU ALONE ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMEMBERING YOUR PASSWORD, AND WE MAY NOT BE ABLE TO HELP YOU IF YOU FORGET IT. WHILE YOUR ACCOUNT CAN ALWAYS BE RESET WITH A NEW PASSWORD, THIS WOULD DELETE ANY ENCRYPTED DATA ON LEGACYVAULT SERVERS.

How Your Information is Used

You can generally visit our Site without revealing any Personally-Identifiable Data about yourself. In order to use the Services, however, we will collect personally identifiable information, such as your name, address, email address, phone number, username, credit card number, and other information (collectively, "Personally-Identifiable Data"). Additionally, we may invite you to participate in surveys, questionnaires or contests, contact us with questions or comments or provide us with feedback, which due to the nature of some of these activities, may include the collection of Personally-Identifiable Data. Additionally, by accessing the Site or using the Services, we might collect additional data as set forth below in the Aggregate Information paragraph below.

We also may use your Personally-Identifiable Data to register you to use our Services, confirm your identify, contact you to deliver certain services, news or information related to the Services, verify your authority to use our Services, and improve the content and general administration of the Site and our Services. If you are unwilling to allow your Personally-Identifiable Data to be used as described in this Section, you should not sign up for or use the Services.

Subject to the terms of this Agreement, no information of any kind is provided to any third party. WE DO NOT SELL DATA TO ANY THIRD PARTY.

LEGACYVAULT does not open, access, scan, or read your stored content files, but does use information about the type of content (i.e., music, video, text, etc.) in order to enhance your experience as a user of the Service.

Use of Demographic Information

LEGACYVAULT may use your demographic information to perform business analyses or to tailor the Site and communications. We will not share any

anonymous aggregated demographic information with advertisers and other third parties.

Aggregate Information

The Site may track the total number of visitors to our Site, the number of visitors to each page of our Site, browser type, and IP addresses, and we may analyze this data for trends and statistics in the aggregate, but such information will be maintained, used and disclosed in aggregate form only and it will not contain personally identifiable information. We may use such aggregate information to analyze trends, administer the Site, track users' movement, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use.

Cookies

Similar to other commercial websites, our website utilizes a standard technology called "Cookies" and web server logs to collect information about how our website is used. A cookie is a very small text document, which often includes an anonymous unique identifier. When you visit a website, that site's computer asks your computer for permission to store this file in a part of your hard drive specifically designated for cookies. Each website can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only allows a website to access the cookies it has sent to you. Your browser prevents that site from accessing cookies from other sites. When you log onto and browse our website, our website server automatically receives and records information on our website server logs from your browser, which may include your IP address, cookie, page(s) viewed, the date and time of visits, and time spent on our website. We do not link any information we store in "cookies" to any personal identifiable information whatsoever.

LEGACYVAULT uses cookies to differentiate you from other users and to improve your user experience. In addition, cookies, in conjunction with our server's log files, allow us to calculate the aggregate number of people that visit our site, and which part of our website draws the most visits. This helps us analyze trends in order to improve our website and better serve our customers.

Links to Third Party Sites

The Site may provide links to other Web sites or resources over which LEGACYVAULT does not have control ("External Web Sites"). Such links do not constitute an endorsement by LEGACYVAULT of those External Web Sites. You acknowledge that LEGACYVAULT is providing these links to you only as a convenience, and further agree that LEGACYVAULT is not responsible for the content of such External Web Sites. Your use of External Web Sites is subject to the terms of use and privacy policies located on such External Web Sites.

Security

We employ procedural and technological security measures that are reasonably designed to help protect your Personally-Identifiable Data from loss, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction, which includes encryption, password protection, and other security measures to help prevent unauthorized access to your Personally-Identifiable Data. The data that you transmit as part of your use of the Services (“Storage Data”) is in encrypted form and LEGACYVAULT does not have access to your Storage Data in its unencrypted form.

Correction/Updating Personally Identifiable Information

LEGACYVAULT provides you with the ability to review, correct and delete any of the Personally-Identifiable Data that you have provided to us; provided, however upon deletion you must cease using the Services since we will no longer be able to provide the Services to you. If you wish to review or correct any Personally-Identifiable Data you have provided to us, you may access your account using the LEGACYVAULT application.

Financial Information

When a user uploads payment information, it is sent to Authorize.net (encrypted over HTTPS), who then gives us a unique ID to reference that payment information, which is then encrypted in our system, that ID is only associated with that specific account. The card/bank-specific information is then stored entirely on Authorize.net. If a user chooses to save a payment method, it's currently stored on Authorize.net's servers indefinitely. If they choose to use a payment method but not save it, the information will be removed from Authorize.net immediately. If the user chooses to delete an existing payment method, it's removed from Authorize.net at that time. **LEGACYVAULT does not store Member's payment information.**

Disclosure to Governmental Entities

LEGACYVAULT may disclose specific contact information when we determine in LEGACYVAULT sole discretion that such disclosure is necessary to:

1. Comply with US laws.
2. To cooperate with or seek assistance from law enforcement.
3. To protect the interests or safety of LegacyVault.com other visitors to the site or users of the Services.

Also, only your contact information may be passed on to a third party in the event of a merger, acquisition, consolidation, divestiture, or a bankruptcy of LEGACYVAULT.
